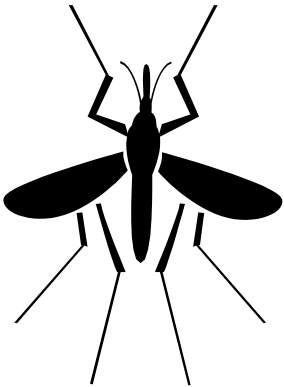
## Special Thanks

## **Pond Update**

### Mosquito Abatement

Remember to pick up your dunks from the Township. The Township tracks the number of households to help determine the need for mosquito abatement.

The Township annual budget granted an additional \$7,000 towards mosquito abatement. Clarke will spray a total of 3 times during the summer months. The first spraying was in June. For information on other dates, please contact Clarke. Their contact number is 800-942-2555. If you want to be notified, you need to state your name, address, phone and state that you are a Libertyville Township resident. This will insure you are notified prior to a spraying.

### Pond Clean Up

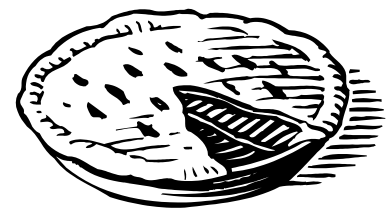
